

2009 Coaching Clinics

It has been a very eventful off-season for Tigard Football as an overall program; however, now that the dust has settled we are ready to begin preparing our coaches for our 2009 Tigard Youth Football campaign. Below are the details to our mandatory (yes, I said it again) coaching clinics –

Details –

- **Where** – Tigard High School auto shop classroom (near 1st base dugout on varsity baseball field)
 - Some days we'll be on the field to execute technique / drills....we will let you know so you can dress for the weather
- **When** – Sunday evenings (see dates below)
- **Time** – varies (see specific date) but will shoot for 5:30 – 7:30 window most days & no more than two hours
- **Who** – All head coaches & first assistants must attend.....however, I encourage all assistants to attend too.
- **Why** – We will be introducing everyone to Tigard's new Head Football Coach – Craig Ruecker (Rooker) & the new schematic philosophies of our program.
 - As we have done each of the past three years we are requiring all teams to operate under the same offensive system.
 - We will cover the terminology, play calling, teaching points, and “every day drills” to succeed in this system at each level.

Dates / Times –

- May 17th – 7 – 9pm (coach Ruecker has a booster club commitment thus the late start)
- May 31st – 5:30 – 7:30pm
- June 7th – 5:30 – 7:30pm
- June 14th – 5:30 – 7:30pm
- June 28th – 5:30 – 7:30pm
- July 12th – 5:30 – 7:30pm
- July 19th – 5:30 – 7:30pm
- These will be posted at www.tigardyouthfootball.com as well as any necessary changes to the schedule.
- Note – if needed we may add a later clinic since we don't begin practice until Aug. 10th. However, would like to give everyone a few weeks off prior to the season fully kicking in.

What to bring –

- An open mind.....this is not your average I-Formation system
- Pen / pencil / notebooks
- Your favorite caffeinated beverage (no alcohol / tobacco)
