Tigard Varsity Black took on Clackamas Red on Saturday night at Tigard High School. Tigard dominated Clackamas behind an amazing performance by running back Manu Rasmussen to come away with 32 to 16 victory. Rasmussen gained 355 yards on 33 carries.

He also scored four touchdowns on runs of 65, 55, 15, and 1 yard. Ramussen ran over and ran past the Clackamas defenders all night. Bradley Imai added 95 yards on 12 rushes, he also scored a touchdown on 1 yard run up the middle. Alex Janac gained 13 yards on 4 carries. Tigard's powerful offense gained 460 yards on the ground , dominating the clock and the game.
